



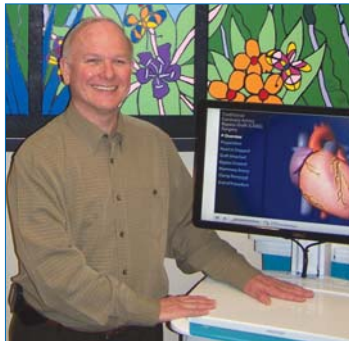
Helping Our Community Shine Brightly

\$443.6 Million in Economic Impact

In fiscal 2009, Methodist Health System contributed more than \$443.6 million to our local community, providing more than \$90.6 million in uncompensated charity care and \$353 million in employee salaries and benefits. We employ 5,986 professionals, making us one of the largest employers in the Dallas/Fort Worth area.

Locally, Methodist Mansfield Medical Center provided more than \$12.2 in unreimbursed charity care and government-sponsored indigent health care. We employ 647 health care professionals, making us one of the largest employers in the Mansfield area.

Methodist Mansfield Shines On

Methodist Mansfield Medical Center is continuing to grow and move forward with the second phase of a \$37 million expansion program underway on the west side of the hospital. The new ICU opened in November 2009 and the Emergency Department expansion is anticipated for completion in April 2010.

"Methodist Mansfield has created a huge economic engine in our community, fostering growth and development that has brought significant increases in property values, including improved bond ratings, greater employment, and better services to our city and our community," says Mansfield City Manager Clayton Chandler. The hospital is also a contributing factor in Mansfield being ranked in the top 25 small cities in the United States by *Money Magazine* this year.

"We are very excited and proud to be expanding our services to serve the health needs of the surrounding area," says Methodist Mansfield Medical Center President Laura Irvine. "We have a great staff, and we are thankful that so many members of our communities have entrusted Methodist Mansfield with their health.
